

UK Government figures on the success of the Creative Industries

In the UK the creative industries are a success story. Government figures tell us:

- The GVA of the creative industries, which is the UK measure of the value of goods and services, was £84.1bn (or CA\$155.5bn) in 2014 and accounted for 5.2% of the UK economy
- Creative industries GVA increased by 8.9% between 2013-14 compared to 4.6% for the whole of the UK

EU Commission figures on the success of the Creative Industries

It's the same positive story comes from the European Union where figures tell us:

- Creative industries add €558 bn (or CA\$805.9bn) in value to GDP (4.4% of total EU GDP)
